I write in relation to the Adelaide Aquatic Centre Code Amendment (the Code Amendment). The Minister for Planning, the Hon Nick Champion MP, has declared a conflict of interest and has delegated this matter to me.

I write to advise that under section 73(10) of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 (the Act), I have considered the advice of the State Planning Commission and the issues raised during the engagement period and have now adopted the Code Amendment.

In adopting the Code Amendment, I am of the view that it will facilitate the development of the new Adelaide Aquatic Centre, and the return of the existing centre's site to Park Lands.

The Code Amendment will come into effect when consolidated into the online Code and published on the PlanSA Portal via the following link: https://code.plan.sa.gov.au/home/browse the planning and design code?code=browse. It is anticipated this will occur in June/July 2023.
