Re; Submission to the Panel, re issues with Ormond Ave., Daw Park (Photos enclosed)

I am a long term resident in Ormond Ave., Daw Park. My car is parked on my property, and I often have cars in front of my home or even opposite my home, (which by the way is an empty block of land), these cars create a limit of my oncoming vision to pull out of my own drive safely when I have appointments.

In my time I have seen my own street and the surrounding area become more cluttered with units and flats, all built on one piece of land, which originally homed 1 family in 1 house, adding to the clutter on the street. We were assured at one time that no more units or flats would be built, even though the damage had been done, yet even now 2 homes are now taking the space of that one block of land. This clutter of homes has of course further increased the problem in Ormond Ave, where cars are parked off properties.

The constant heavy flow of traffic has always been a problem, coming from both directions i.e. Goodwood Road & Winston Ave.

Please be aware that Ormond Ave. is very narrow and due to cars parked on the street it is impossible to drive on it without stopping many times, sitting behind parked cars to await safe passage for oncoming cars. I have also had cars speeding past me whilst I was waiting courteously for oncoming traffic, to the point now that I switch on my right turn indicator to prevent this sort of selfish behaviour and an accident.

Adding to the problem is a Child Care Centre and a doctors surgery, who have provided limited parking (I know this, as I attended this clinic for my Covid vaccinations and was never able to park in their car park, fair enough they are very busy).

I was supportive of a neighbour several years ago who rallied to try to fix this serious problem. I know most of my neighbours were pleased with his effort and dedication and his family offered many sensible suggestions to our local council. I of course refer to the permanent residents, not those renting, who come and go over the years in those flats and units as referenced above.

Yet still NOTHING HAS CHANGED!!! In fact more traffic still, uses Ormond Ave.

His was not the first request for this problem to be fixed, yet here we are in 2022, still putting up with the constant barrage of traffic passing through and the clutter of cars parked in the street. Please make a change!
