Dear Planning Review Panel

I am writing to provide feedback on the ease of community access to information on the PlanSA Website.

I was informed by my local council that a review of the planning system was underway so looked on the PlanSA website. As it is a significant review I expected to find a link to it on the front page of the web site, either under *News*, or the *Planning and Design Code* section. I looked under the news section but could not find it (most news feeds allow you to pin an important or ongoing item near the top of the news feed). I then looked under the *Have you Say* section but could not find it. After spending over 30 minutes looking for it I went to my local council's website and found a link to the review section on the PlanSA website (https://plan.sa.gov.au/planning_review). The HTTP address indicates it is a page under the home page, but there is no link on the home page. Also the news stories in the news section of the review are not linked into the news section on the home page.

The difficulty I had in finding the review information on the PlanSa website almost indicated it was being hidden. More thought should have been given to placing such an important issue in a prominent position on the front page of the PlanSA web site.
