
Online Planning and Design Code

Frequently Asked Questions



Q – When can the public view the Planning and Design Code in the ePlanning platform?

A – From 29 June, the online Code for Phase One (Outback areas) and Phase Two (Rural Areas) will be available at www.code.plan.sa.gov.au

Q – Will I need a login to access the online Planning and Design Code?

A – No login details are required, simply enter the web address in your browser and explore the online Code.

Q - Can I access the whole ePlanning system?

A – The ePlanning system includes the new planning portal, the online Planning and Design Code, the South Australian Property and Planning Atlas (SAPPA), and the Development Application Processing system. The online Planning and Design Code and SAPPA mapping will be publicly available from 29 June. The new planning portal and Development Application Processing system will be available when the system is implemented on 31 July 2020.

Q – When will the Phase Two Code be activated?

A – The Phase Two Code is on track to be implemented across rural SA on Friday 31 July 2020, subject to the Minister for Planning's adoption of the Code.

Q – Will the ePlanning system show metropolitan addresses?

A – Not yet. From 29 June, the online Planning and Design Code will only display results for addresses in outback and rural areas of the state. Metropolitan and urban addresses in large regional towns, whilst able to be entered, will not display a result as the Phase Three Planning and Design Code has not yet been added to the ePlanning system.

Q – When will the Phase Three Code be available?

A – The third and final phase of SA's new planning system for urban and metropolitan areas of South Australia is under active consideration by the State Planning Commission. A What We Have Heard Report that summaries, at a high level, submissions on the draft Phase Three Code is now available on the SA Planning Portal. The Phase Three Code is on track to be implemented later this year.
