

PEREGRINE MIXED USE DEVELOPMENT



The Peregrine Mixed Use Development at 270 The Parade, Kensington was originally declared a Major development on **26 November 2015**. A varied declaration was made on **15 September 2016**.

The development involves the demolition of the existing Peregrine head office and construction of a new multi-storey mixed use building comprising retail and café spaces, office spaces, public restaurant and gymnasium, business related accommodation premises, car parking and related services / utilities. The aim of the development is to meet Peregrine's growing demand for quality office space and improved work facilities and amenities.

The proposal will support Peregrine's business operations within South Australia which currently employ over 3100 people across the state (including 249 employees located in the existing head office). At a development cost of \$50 million the project has the potential to generate 560 full time equivalent development industry jobs. With the addition of retail spaces and a restaurant the proposal is expected to generate 110 retail and/or hospitality jobs.
