I am addressing this to you at your electorate address as after 5 minutes searching I could not find your ministerial address. I trust it will be passed on to your Planning Ministerial office for response & action.



This is to advise that along with many other residents, I am particularly concerned with the Planning Act as it affects the proposed Code & request that you support a request to have the Act amended:

- to restore the third-party appeal rights over disputed planning assessments to ratepayers & residents
- to remove the new development proponents' exclusive appeal rights in the same instances
- to restore more elected members to panels & commissions that assess planning assessment determinations
- & to remove new, fixed, tight deadlines on planning assessments that give automatic approval even if a planner has not been satisfied that key information has been provided.

The current situation will put even more power into developers' hands but they do not have to live with the consequences, we do.

I should appreciate a response as to your stand on this matter.
