SEA Gas has made a separate letter submission strongly supporting the proposed amendments to the *Gas and Liquid Petroleum Pipelines Overlay* and the introduction of the *Gas and Liquid Petroleum Pipelines (Facilities) Overlay* in the *Draft Planning and Design Code for Urban Areas*.

These overlays are far better aligned with the requirements of the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Act* (and therefore the requirements that pipeline operators must meet under a pipeline licence) and the overriding principles of protecting public safety, the environment and security of gas supply than the *Strategic Infrastructure Gas Pipelines Overlay* in the *Planning and Design Code for Rural and Outback Areas of South Australia*. We would also strongly support this overlay and the *Gas and Liquid Petroleum Pipelines (Facilities) Overlay* replacing the *Strategic Infrastructure Gas Pipelines Overlay* in the *Planning and Design Code for Rural and Outback Areas of South Australia*.
