IWS NORTHERN BALEFILL – LOWER LIGHT

RELEASE OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE EIS FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

The IWS Northern Balefill (Dublin Landfill) was approved by the Governor of South Australia on 29 January 1998 under the *Development Act 1993* (having previously undergone an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) level of assessment).

The facility is owned by Pelican Asset Co Pty, and trades as Integrated Waste Services (IWS).

Pursuant to Section 114(2)(b) of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*, IWS has lodged a request for a variation to the current development authorisation (EIS Amendment) with the Minister for Planning. The amendment seeks to provide increased flexibility in future internal cell configuration and processing pad locations, an increase to the permissible maximum landfill height from 23 metres AHD to 28 metres AHD (i.e. 5 metre increase), removal of volumetric calculations and removal of prescriptive requirements for leachate extraction pumps.

The proponent has now submitted an **Amendment to the EIS** that addresses the above proposed changes, which has been released for public consultation from **5th April 2023 until 1 May 2023**.
