My husband and I purchased our house in tree-lined Addison Road, Black Forest in 1981 as a place to raise our future children.

The proposal to zone our area "General Neighbourhood" does not fit the style of our area. I urge you to reconsider zoning us "Suburban Neighbourhood".

Many old blocks are already narrow, creating driveways close together with limited street parking. Many people have more vehicles now than decades ago and removal trucks, tradies, delivery vehicles, lawnmowing services and caravans need much longer street parking spaces.

Rubbish/recycle collection is also very different now than in the past and requires much more kerb space.

The health and wellbeing of people is adversely affected by lack of trees and other vegetation, lack of light and sun and lack of personal space and privacy.

Trees are vital for their beauty, shade and heat reduction in summer.
