The purpose of this email is to write to you about the State Government's new Draft Planning Code.

Under the State Government's new Draft Planning Code, the State Planning Commission has determined that Linden Park is to be rezoned from a Suburban Neighbourhood Zone to a General Neighbourhood Zone. The impact of this will lead to a greater and/or closer concentration of housing, more street congestion and street parking, a reduction in green space and an increase in pollution.

I bought into Linden Park and continue to live in the area on the basis of the current street scape, zoning and community feel. The proposed rezoning of Linden Park to General Neighbourhood zone is a great concern to me and does not have my support.

I have also written a letter to Vicki Chapman advising her of my concerns and that I have been a Liberal Party voter and supporter, both Federal and State, my entire life. If the aforementioned Draft Planning Code proceeds as currently drafted I will no longer vote or support the State and Federal Liberal party. This is the same position as many of my friends and family who live in Linden Park.
