### Your Feedback

My background is that I worked in a regulatory role of the SA Government with oversight of high pressure gas and liquid petroleum pipelines for the period 1994 to 2008. Since then I have worked in private industry, primarily as a risk engineer facilitating safety management workshops for many of the major high pressure gas and liquid petroleum pipelines in Australia, including projects where new developments near pipelines are considered. For the period 1999 to present I have been actively involved in various committees responsible for developing the Australian standard for high pressure gas and liquid petroleum pipelines (*AS/NZS 2885 Pipelines – Gas and liquid petroleum*). I am currently the Convenor of the sub-committee responsible for *AS/NZS 2886.6 Pipeline Safety Management*.

This background is simply provided as context with regard to my personal knowledge and experience upon which my comments are based. My comments should in no way be interpreted to represent those of Standards Australia, my employer, the pipeline industry, or any other party.

I fully support the provisions that require that high pressure gas and liquid petroleum pipelines are recognized early in the life of development planning processes, so that all stakeholders can take into account both the development objectives and the public safety issues that need to be addressed when developments near pipelines are proposed.

The proposed amendments are consistent with objective of formal “planning notifications zones” in AS/NZS 2885.6 as one of a suite of controls which contribute to minimizing the risks to public safety, security of supply and the environment.
