Good morning, I have just heard you on 891. One of the things that has concerned me since moving into Hewett some years ago, is the lack of playing for pedestrians, in particular those with a disability or young children. I have contacted the Light Council regarding my concerns and they have responded to my letters but say it is not a problem. The issue is that the paths are right next to the roadways and there are no verges. The streets are narrow and curved. Many people park their cars on the path to avoid getting hit. The council agree this is unacceptable but they do not police it. So pedestrians are obligated to walk on the road. Also when it is bin day the bins on the pathway means that the pedestrians must use the road. Children or the disabled are most at risk.
