I learnt of new proposed developments in our area recently.
I tried to submit my comments via online feedback but was unable to get through the code.

I've been a resident of South Plympton for 10 years. What attracted us to the area was the older, established suburb with a convenient location.
In the last few years however this established suburb had changed. Older houses are getting knocked down and are replaced with 2-3 properties instead. This brings less greenery, more cars and houses roof to roof next to each other. Block sizes are getting smaller and smaller.
Some of the streets have so many cars parked on them, it is hard to have two way traffic.
