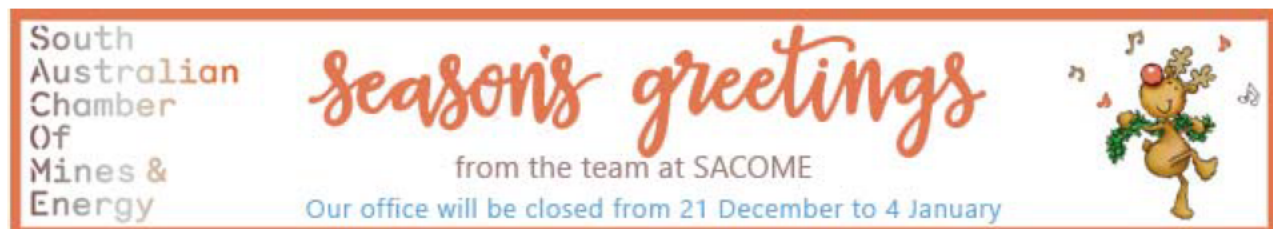

The South Australian Chamber of Mines and Energy (SACOME) is the peak industry body representing companies with interests in the South Australian minerals, energy extractive, oil and gas sectors and associated service providers.

SACOME supports the submissions of its member companies' Sea Gas and Epic Energy in favour of the proposed amendments to the 'Gas and Liquid Petroleum Pipelines Overlay' and the introduction of the 'Gas and Liquid Petroleum Pipelines (Facilities) Overlay' in the revised Phase Three (Urban Areas) Code (the Code).

SACOME notes the proposed amendments to the Code safeguard against development approvals that are incompatible with the safe operation of pipelines, as required under the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Act 2000*.
