Having lived in the area for 14 years, we have seen many changes, with more properties being demolished only to find the multiple dwellings are built. These dwellings often have little to no outdoor areas and garden space, which has to have an effect on the climate, in addition to additional pressure on council and state facilities.

As a teacher at a local school, I have noticed the increase in student numbers in classes and the number of enrolments, with disappointed parents having to accept that students cannot attend their local school. Increase student numbers on various sites have placed restrictions on play, over the years, with schools taking measures to ensure student safety and well-being.

To further decrease the land size for proposed properties, in addition to other changes to boundaries etc, would be disgraceful. Additional increases in population would place more strain on schools and kindergartens and other community facilities.
