I wish to strongly object to the the SA Govt's plan to re-zone sections of Mile End, Torrensville, Cowandilla and Hilton into a Housing Diversity neighbour zone. These suburbs are full of character homes and the thought of high density mixed housing and business being mixed in these suburbs is of great concern.

Suburban Neighbourhood Zone is far more fitting in my view.

While I understand the need to limit the outer spread of Adelaide metro area there are other options available. Adelaide Airport sits on 780ha of prime near city land. I submit the SA Govt should negotiate with the Federal Govt to plan for the relocation of Adelaide Airport away from the near city suburbs. Re-developing such a massive expanse of land would revitalise Adelaide, create employment and future proof a new Adelaide Airport capable of operating 24 hours a day.
