Recommendation

It is recommended that the Expert Panel (the Panel) resolves to:

- Approve the designation of the Agenda Report as Not Confidential (Release Immediately), with the exception of **Attachment 1** (Workshop Briefing Paper 2 – *Planning, Development* and Infrastructure Act 2016 Review) which is designated as Not Confidential (Release Delayed) (clause 2.2.2 of the Transparency and Confidentiality Policy) with release being triggered by the public release of the Expert Panel's Final Report to the Minister;
- 2. Note the analysis and options for review on the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* as described in the Workshop Briefing Paper (**Attachment 1**); and
- 3. Approve the content of the Workshop Briefing Paper (**Attachment 1**) being included in the Discussion Paper to assist with public consultation by the Panel.

Background

- At its meeting on 23 August 2022, the Expert Panel (the Panel) considered and determined the matters that would fall within its scope of review of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure* Act 2016 (the Act).
- 2. At its meeting on 5 September 2022, the Panel received a workshop briefing on the matters that it had determined would fall within the scope of the review of the Act.
- Following receipt of the workshop briefing, the Panel identified matters that it sought further clarity on so that it could determine whether such matters ought to be identified and included in the Discussion Paper prepared for the review of the Act.
- 4. The purpose of this report is to now provide the Panel with a second workshop briefing and advice on those specific matters.





Discussion

- 5. The Panel is required to consider the issues for review under the Act, and to make recommendations to the Minister as to how these issues can be remedied or otherwise improved, moving forward.
- 6. To ensure that the Panel receives a relevant, current, and comprehensive understanding of this area for review, subject matter experts from Planning Land Use Services have now prepared a second workshop briefing for the Panel to ensure it is wholly appraised of all relevant matters in advance of determining what will be included in the Discussion Paper on the Act.
