## Introduction to the Summary Papers

South Australia's planning system has undergone significant change in recent years. Firstly, with the implementation of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* (PDI Act) and *Planning, Development, and Infrastructure (General) Regulations 2017* (the Regulations) and more recently with the introduction of the state-wide Planning and Design Code (the Code).

The Minister for Planning, the Hon. Nick Champion, has commissioned an Expert Panel which is tasked with reviewing key aspects of the planning system and identifying opportunities to ensure planning decisions encourage a more liveable, competitive, affordable, and sustainable long-term growth strategy for Greater Adelaide and the regions.

Discussion Papers on the PDI Act, the Code and the e-Planning System are now available. In an effort to encourage as many people as possible to provide feedback to the Panel, Summary Papers have been produced on each of the following topics:

- Tree Policy in the Code
