The time and manner of public consultation do not conform to the Charter of Community Engagement adopted by the government. The Planning and Design Code is set out in a manner that makes it unwieldy and difficult to understand. Simple matters like a table of contents, indexes and page numbers have been omitted, which makes it difficult for me to find information concerning planning controls in my area.

The Contributory Items that exist in many council areas should be specifically mentioned in the Code and included in relevant overlays. This has been a matter in which the voices of the many concerned citizens have been ignored in favour of the wishes of a loud but tiny minority of developers.

Provisions allowing demolition of historic places on grounds of structural condition and 'economic' costs of maintenance and repair will invite unscrupulous owners to allow properties on valuable parcels of land to neglect their upkeep in order to realize windfall profits.
