The development violated all the planning guidelines regarding retention of open space, tree cover, building height, building footprint, closeness to the boundary,etc.

The appeal was successful but was subsequent]ntly approved by the Council planning staff without any consultation with the several neighbours who were party to the original objection.

Whilst Hawthorn has traditionally had good tree cover and green space this is rapidly being lost due to housing development which remove all vegetation and cover virtually the entire block with concrete and a massive house, pool tank etc.
