Goolwa Wharf Code Amendment

What is a Code Amendment?

In South Australia, the State Government's Planning and Design Code (the Code) outlines how you can and cannot develop your property. It is publicly accessible on Plan SA.

Any proposed changes to the Code requires a 'Code Amendment', which is underpinned by a thorough engagement process.

What is proposed?

Council is proposing an amendment to the Code as it relates to parcels of land currently situated within the Goolwa Wharf area.

Prior to the Planning and Design Code new system (2021), Council used the 'Policy 6 Area Goolwa Wharf and Surrounds', which was more accommodating of the uses of the Wharf Precinct.

Right now, this land is zoned 'Infrastructure (Ferry and Marina Facilities) Zone' which is focussed on ferry and marina development.

Council is proposing a new Goolwa Wharf Subzone to better reflect the Precinct's unique character, rich First Nations heritage, and important role in the State's riverboat and steam railway history.

The proposed changes aim to:

- Celebrate and protect the area's heritage
- Support community use
- Encourage tourism activities
- Help revitalise the Goolwa Wharf precinct

Who will be affected?

A map showing the area affected by the new Goolwa Wharf Subzone is shown on the next page.

The change will enable future alterations (subject to development approval) to current infrastructure that enhance or create opportunities to expand the current land uses.

Who does this not affect?

- PS Oscar W waterbased operations
- Existing operations e.g. hospitality businesses, Signal Point Experience Centre, function of the bridge etc. (from a land use perspective)
- All existing historic and state heritage policy will not be removed or amended
